# **SPANISH (SPAN)**

#### SPAN 1003, Spanish for Workplace Professi (3 Credit Hours)

3 lecture hours per week, 0 lab hours per week, 3 contact hours per week This course is designed to prepare professionals to communicate effectively when providing care and attention to Spanish speakers in workplace settings. This course provides transcultural training that emphasizes the basics for interpersonal communication, both oral and written. The goal of the course is to enhance the quality of interaction between Spanish speakers and workplace professionals. This course may not be transferable to a University for use towards a 4-year degree program.

### SPAN 1014, Elementary Spanish I (4 Credit Hours)

4 lecture hours per week, 0 lab hours per week, 4 contact hours per week For students with no previous study of Spanish. Supplementary work in language laboratory. Basic lexicon and structure of Spanish; emphasis on communicative language use. Native speakers of Spanish will not receive credit.

## SPAN 1024, Elementary Spanish II (4 Credit Hours)

4 lecture hours per week, 0 lab hours per week, 4 contact hours per week Supplementary work in language laboratory. Basic lexicon and structure of Spanish; emphasis on communicative language use. Native speakers of Spanish will not receive credit.

Prerequisite(s): SPAN 1014 or 1101.

#### SPAN 2013, Intermediate Spanish I (3 Credit Hours)

3 lecture hours per week, 0 lab hours per week, 3 contact hours per week Continuation of elementary Spanish. Additional emphasis on reading and writing. Native speakers of Spanish will not receive credit. **Prerequisite(s):** SPAN 1014 or 1102.

## SPAN 2023, Intermediate Spanish II (3 Credit Hours)

3 lecture hours per week, 0 lab hours per week, 3 contact hours per week Continuation of Intermediate Spanish I. Additional emphasis on reading and writing. Native speakers of Spanish will not receive credit.
